Statement on Inclement Weather

In cases of inclement weather, decisions will be based on the safety of the children. We have children playing between the ages of 4 and 15 and the criteria used to measure safe conditions are different depending on the age of the players. The Soccer Commissioner (or other soccer committee member if he is not present) will make the decision about whether games will be played or not.

NO GAMES WILL BE PLAYED IF THERE IS THUNDER OR LIGHTNING.

If a storm with thunder and lightning suddenly comes up during a game, everyone should take shelter in their cars and wait 20 minutes to see if it passes.

Games will not be cancelled if it is only raining. If the rain creates UNSAFE FIELD CONDITIONS, the games will be cancelled. As a parent, you always have the right to not allow your child to play if you feel the conditions are unsafe.

In the event the games are cancelled, coaches will be called who will then call their players.

Every attempt will be made to reschedule and play cancelled games. However, this is not always possible depending on the time of year and/or other conflicting events.
